For your bibliography, include the following:

- 1 a minimum of *three sources*
- 2. a maximum of *one source* can be in Japanese

Japanese sources do not have to be translated, but they have to be written in the roman alphabet (no Chinese characters, hiragana or katakana)

- 3. Use the correct format for your bibliography:
 - a. title, your name and date
 - b. single space your sources; a single space between each source
 - c. a hanging indent for the second line of sources
 - d. Times New Roman font; size 12
- 4. Use APA referencing to organize the information of each source:
 - a. use capitalization and punctuation correctly
- 5. Make your bibliography in MS Word.
- 6. Use the following file format for the name of your document:
 - IE3W-Bib-given name
 - o e.g. IE3W-Bib-Nanami
- 7. Attach your bibliography as a document in your email.
- 8. In the subject name of your email, use the following format:
 - IE3W: Bibliography-given name
 - o e.g. IE3W: Bibliography-Nanami
- ★ Bibliographies must be submitted on time to receive corrections. Those submitted late do not receive corrections.
- ★ "Computer problems" are not an acceptable excuse for late tasks. Manage your time to avoid problems.
