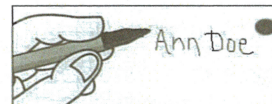
**How to Mark Your Paper Ballot:**

- Fill in the **Oval** to the right of your selection **completely**
- Use a black or blue ink pen. **NO RED INK**
- Do not use check marks, X's, lines or circles
- No personal info or identification marks on your Official Ballot



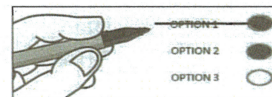
**Write-In Voting:**

- Print the name of the qualified write-in candidate in the blank space provided
- Fill in the oval completely to the right of the write-in space
- Do not write in a candidate name already printed on the ballot



**Avoid Over-Voting.** To ensure your vote counts, do not vote for more candidates than allowed for each contest.




If you make a **mistake**, request a replacement Ballot or if there is not enough time to receive a replacement ballot by mail, you may correct it by crossing out the wrong choice and filling out the correct oval as shown in picture.



**Voting by Mail:**

- For Ballot replacement, call (408) 299-VOTE (8683) or toll free (866) 430-VOTE (8683)
- After completing your Ballot, **detach the top numbered stub**. Place your voted Ballot into your return envelope, complete the envelope and **SIGN** your name by the red "X" in order for the ballot to be counted
- Your signature **must match** the signature on your voter registration card

**[ SIGNATURE (REQUIRED) / FIRMA (REQUERIDA) ]**

Signature must be in voter's own handwriting. (Do not print)

**Your voted ballot MUST be returned by 8 p.m. on Election Day OR postmarked on or before election day and received no later than 17 days after Election Day.**  
**Deliver or mail your ballot early, so it can be included in the first Election Night Results!**

**Return Options:**

- ✓ Mail your ballot. **No postage required**
- ✓ Return at any **Official Ballot Drop Box**
- ✓ Return at any **Vote Center**
- ✓ You may authorize someone other than the voter in writing to return Ballot

Let you know where your ballot is, and its status, every step of the way.
