In last week's class, on May 25th, we heard 6 Olympic bid presentations and there are 3 remaining ones. They will be given at the beginning of our June 1st class:

Group 4: Madrid, Spain

Group 5: Pretoria, Republic of South Africa

Group 6: Amsterdam, Netherlands

Dias collected, in an Excel file, the feedback that students (and he) gave for each of the Olympic bid presentations through the Google Form. The Excel file with the feedback for your group was sent to each of the groups' leaders. Your leader should have sent you that feedback so that you could see it. If they didn't, please ask them to do so. After looking at the feedback and reflecting on your group's performance, answer these questions by June 7th in the Small Group "Reflecting on Olympic Bid Presentation":

- 1) How well do you think your group did in convincing the audience that the Olympics should be held in the host city you were introducing?
- 2) Did everything in your presentation go “as planned” or were there some complications? Please explain.
- 3) Do you think it would have been easier or more difficult if you had gotten together in person to plan and practice your presentation?
- 4) Did collaborating with your fellow group members go smoothly? Explain your process(es) of communicating and working with each other. What worked well and what did you struggle with? What technologies (apps, etc.) helped with your preparation?
- 5) If you were to do the presentation all over again, what would you have done differently?
