

Gender Awareness Workshops

In place of a final test there will be a final “presentation,” which will be in the form of a workshop your group will have to carry out related to gender issues.

Each of you have been assigned to a group that will be conducting a workshop for your classmates (that is, your classmates will take the role of workshop participants).

Below you will find the groups that will conduct these gender awareness workshops (18 minutes each) on July 13th and 20th using the materials from the “Gender Awareness and Development Manual.” This manual was created by the Ministry of Women’s Affairs Training and Advocacy Department of Afghanistan in conjunction with the United Nations Development Programme. Links to the PDFs of these materials can be found below.

Although the materials indicate times (for example, 25 minutes) that each of the workshop tasks will take, you will have to customize them so that they fit into your 18-minute slot. You cannot take longer than 18 minutes or your classmates will not have time for their presentations. Depending on the particular workshop you’ll be conducting, you may have to leave out (or add to) parts of the materials provided to you.

The important thing is that you actually teach your audience (classmates) something valuable about gender issues and make them think about the issue deeply. Keep in mind that although there might be a mini presentation embedded in the workshop, a workshop is NOT a presentation. It involves the ACTIVE participation from the audience (in this case, your classmates).

ALL GROUPS should read the PDF of the INTRODUCTION to understand your role as “workshop facilitators” better. Look carefully at the excellent glossary at the end of this document on gender-related vocabulary:
